New Business:

This meeting was specifically for the presentation that needed to be made by Kathy Moyer from Electricities our energy provider currently. Who suggested that we participate in the rate study that is coming up. She went over the towns history with rates were we did a 10% decrease in 2015, and then did a 1.7% increase in 2017. These were noted because on the rate study we had in 2016 we were not going to raise the rate until this year and next year by 2.4% not 1.7%. She did suggest that we have this study done using the system betterment grant that Electricities provides us every year which would allow us to be able to do the study at no cost. They would be equal in value and cost, so it would be a wash. Commissioner Freeman suggested that to electricities before this meeting that there be an increase in minimum charge not a rate increase to help with the cost for customers. Commissioner Spivey asked questions as to why, and was given verbal information about how it can be given to look into our capital improvement plan as well as to cover the cost of them manually having to transfer all the data by hand because they can't upload from our system.
