Public Comment

At this time the only public comment which was made by a town resident whom asked for the minutes from the meeting the day before. The resident was informed that they were not readily typed and accessible at this meeting, but the Town Clerk, went over the meeting verbally to the sufficiency of the board for what was discussed at the public hearing. With the issues that had been questioned being addressed.

New Business:

Motion to adopt the Budget Ordinance. Motion made by Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Commissioner Spivey. Unanimous Decision 5-0.

A town resident asked about the increase in tax rates, which was explained by Mayor Goodrich, to have been done to get us back to where we were. A previous board had lowered tax rates from .61 to .57 a few years prior and the board was raising them back to .61 to get the town back to where they were before. Motion to raise the tax rates to .61 on every \$100.00 value made by Commissioner Stewart, seconded by Commissioner Morring. Unanimous decision 5-0.

Another town resident asked because of comments previously made by the board and the other residents, whether a debt was inherited to the new board from the old board. To which Mayor Goodrich responded that it had not been, that these things can happen over time but that they as the current board are just trying to do what is best for the town.

Motion to Accept the Budget Amendments. Motion made by Commissioner Morring, seconded by Commissioner Goodrich. Unanimous Decision 5-0.

Motion to adopt the new budget. Motion made by Commissioner Morring, seconded by Commissioner Goodrich. Unanimous Decision 5-0.

Lastly a town resident asked about the tax rate increase, Mayor Goodrich stated that he was uncertain but that he would get back to her with that information at the next meeting to be held on July 2^{nd} .

Motion to adjourn special call meeting made by Commissioner Morring, seconded by Commissioner Spivey. Unanimous 5-0 vote.
